- Reduce its carbon footprint through prudent use of energy, use of energy-efficient technologies and by switching to renewable alternatives where these can be shown to give actual reductions in carbon emissions.
- Manage and reduce its water consumption.
- Minimise waste production and divert from landfill through increasing re-use, recycling and recovery.

- Prevent pollution and environmental damage from incidents and emergencies.
- Promote and support environmentally responsible behaviour throughout the workplace.
- Set, monitor and review relevant objectives and demonstrate continuous improvement as part of the environmental management plan.
