



HAZGREEN LTD COVID-19 POLICY

As the Coronavirus situation across the globe continues, we need to ensure the wellbeing of our staff, customers, and suppliers. As such, we will continue to monitor and follow Government, NHS England and WHO (World Health Organisation) advice daily. We are currently operating a near normal service albeit with extra safety precautions having been implemented where possible and where required. All office-based functions continue working remotely from home until further notice.

No one can predict the full impact of this virus and it continues to be a moving target. Following the recent Government announcements, our operatives will attend, as a priority, sites where service is essential. We will endeavour to meet all customer requests but due to circumstances outside of our control there may be times, despite our reasonable endeavours, it may take a little longer to complete.

In line with guidance from the UK Government and World Health Organisation, on the prevention of the spread of the virus, we have been putting precautionary safety measures in place including:

Covid 19 Risk Assessments for our staff and site visits.

Monitoring staff sickness and ensuring staff are aware of symptoms to look out for.

Educating our staff on prevention.

We have shared with staff the guidelines for frequent and proper handwashing.

Providing hand sanitisers.

Following government advise any staff showing cold/flu like symptoms will for 7 days self-isolate/work from home.

Hazgreen operatives are instructed to use all appropriate and relevant PPE equipment as advised on a regular basis when working on site and to keep washing their hands on a regular basis.

We have implemented a 'no handshake' policy for all staff.

Hazgreen employees will adhere to the 'two metre' rule to distance themselves where possible.

Hazgreen operatives will not request customers in the field to provide an electronic signature or to complete any paperwork during this time and whilst the virus remains a threat. Photographic evidence of collections will be taken for reference if agreeable by our customers.

All Hazgreen employees are expected to adhere to and follow all site instructions and policies, when visiting customers premises, particularly in respect to this virus.

Our Business Continuity Plan has been reviewed, modified, and tested in light of the new Coronavirus threat. Depending on government guidelines we are confident it will ensure continuation of our services.
